Summary of Last Conference

SOCAMATYC February 23 – 24, 2018 Moss, Marshes, and Mathematics

The conference was held by our outstanding hosts at the Technical College of the Low Country.

Friday February 23, 2018

The conference started with the opening session presented by our President Dr. Nestberg. Topics discussed included a new AMATYC scholarship, implementing Teaching Excellence award and pertaining qualifications, the next conference location, call for attendance to AMATYC conference next year, and a discussion about where to hold the next conference. Dr. Nestberg shared many resources she obtained from the AMATYC conference in 2017.

Afterwards, many went and enjoyed the experience of painting and each other's company at the Wine Your Art event.

Saturday 24, 2018

The conference had three blocks of session starting at 9:00 AM.

Topics included: Integrating Mind Mapping, Google Drive and Apps in Probability and Statistics, Learning is a Skill, Alternative Approaches to Teaching Math, Individualized Assessment and Academic Mindset Development for Higher Retention, COMAP's Mathematical Contest, Captioning Assistance Programs, Change of Variable Formulas in Calculus, Highlights and Valuable Teaching Resources from AMATYC conference, Goldfish Statistics, MindTap Math Foundations, and Strategies for student success in MyLab Math.

After lunch, Paul Mark Sadka gave a thought provoking and interesting discussion on the Language of Mathematics.

The conference concluded with the closing session and a few words from Dr. Nestberg.

A New SOCAMATYC Teaching Excellence Award was proposed at last year's conference.
